

Mural programme offers 'Street Art' workshop

Totalling four Sunday sessions, held on 8, 15, 22 February and 1 March, this modern course taught by street artist Jean "Jonty" Van Iddekinge and local artist Jo Austin will explore forms of street art through stenciling, exploring composition and the power of images.

Students will then learn the tactical methods of street art through the completion of a public mural piece.

The workshop will accommodate all ages and students will be split into groups according to age and sessions will be held from 8am to 12pm.

The first two sessions will be held at the

National Gallery, Harbour Place location and the final two sessions will be at the NGCI Community Mural Programme site next to the Glass House on Elgin Ave.

The cost is \$80 with a 10 per cent discount for Gallery members. Materials and refreshments are included.
