An exhibition by Davin Ebanks

Growing up in the "the Islands time forgot" Davin Ebanks spent most of his formative years on the water and his love for the sea grew steadily, as did his skills and lore of his seafaring heritage.

Appropriately, and not surprisingly then, Blue Meridian is an artist's soliloquy on what it means to him to be Caymanian – an exploration of his maritime heritage, a study of the water that surrounds his home and ultimately, how he fits into it all. From the life-sized glass models of our tropical waters to carefully cast turtle skulls and catboat blueprints, the works in this exhibition offer a fresh examination of the relationship between identity and environment. They capture Cayman's heritage in an entirely unique way.
