American photojournalist, David Douglas Duncan is among the most influential photographers of the 20th century. Taken early on in his career, this collection features some of the first recorded photographs of Caymanian turtle fishermen on the Mosquito Cays. These landmark images “helped to open Cayman to the rest of the world” when published by National Geographic in August 1943. The stunning original prints, dated 1939, were donated to the Cayman Islands National Archive by the artist.

The Collection has never been exhibited in the Cayman Islands.
