A survey of Cayman Islands Art History

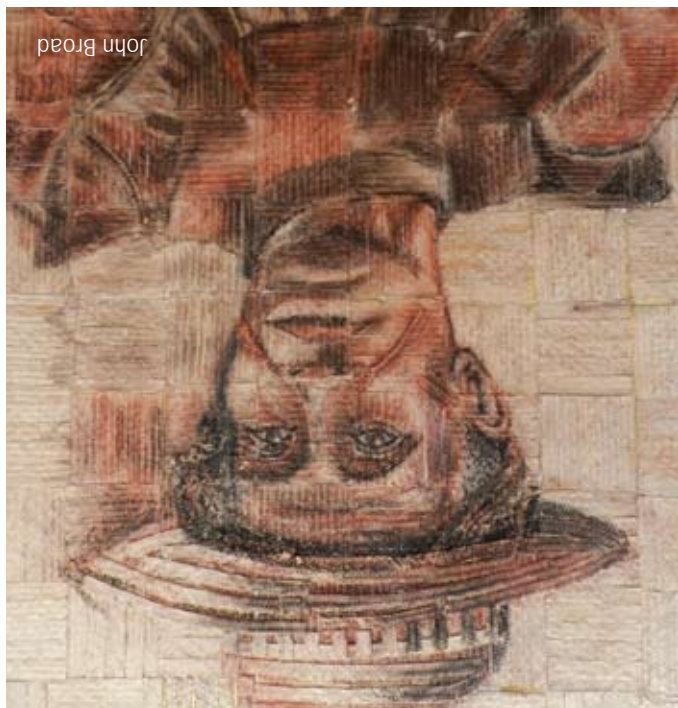
