

## NGCI STUDENT TOURS

The National Gallery offers the following options for school visits:

School visits run from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Mondays to Fridays and booking should be made no later than one week in advance. Transportation assistance is available on a need basis and can be arranged through the NGCI Education Department.

### Option 1

FREE: UP TO 75 MIN

#### MINDS INSPIRED — ACTIVE LEARNING SERIES

These interactive lessons sponsored by Dart have defined learning objectives that are demonstrably achieved. The Active Learning Series use artworks from the National Collection to encourage critical thinking and build communication and problem solving skills within a supportive environment that promotes creativity and expression.
