Looking at Exhibition Labels!

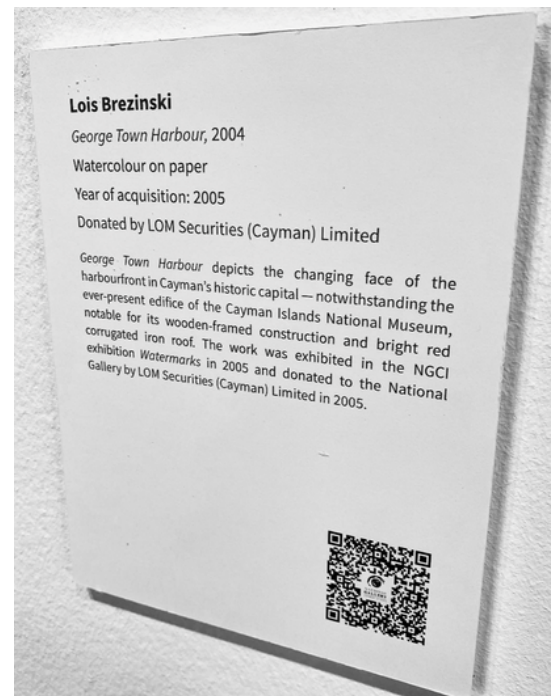
Look at the wall next to each artwork. You will see a small square of writing called a 'label'.



Labels help to explain all the details and the meaning of an artwork.

They usually include:

- The artist's name
- The title of the artwork
- The date the artwork was created
- The medium or material that the artwork is made of
- Who owns the artwork
- A description of the artwork

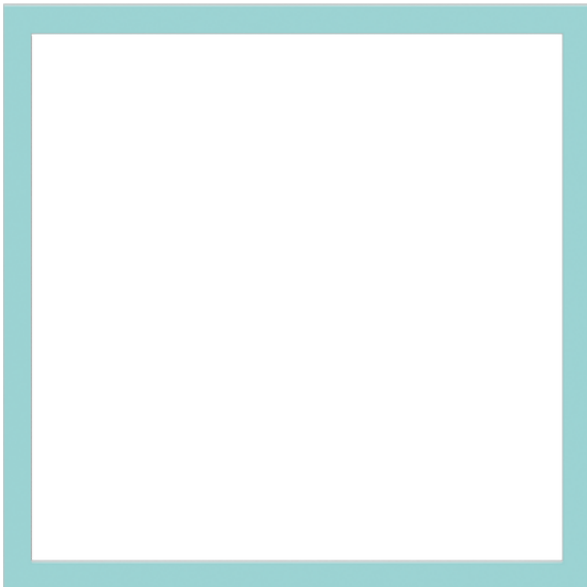

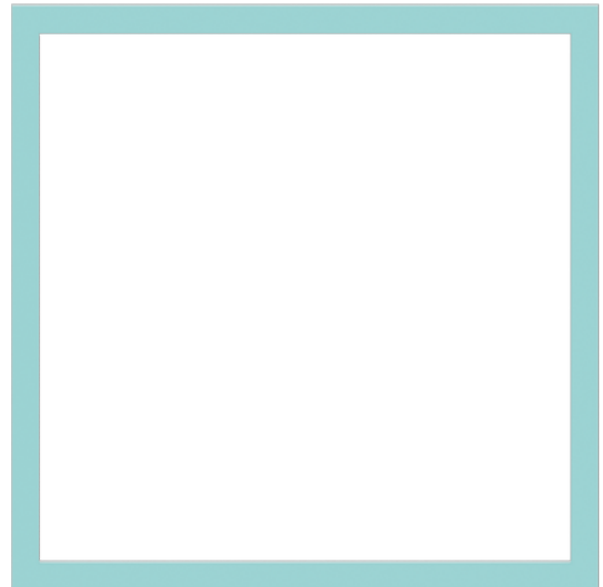
What an artist chooses to call their art can help us to understand its meaning.

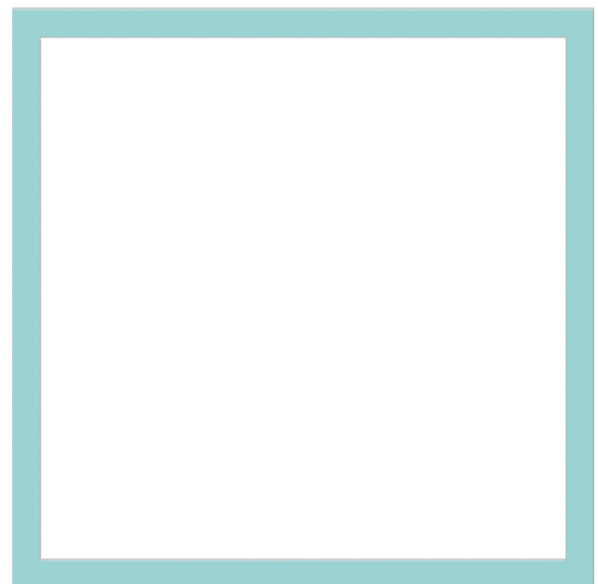
Mother and Child II

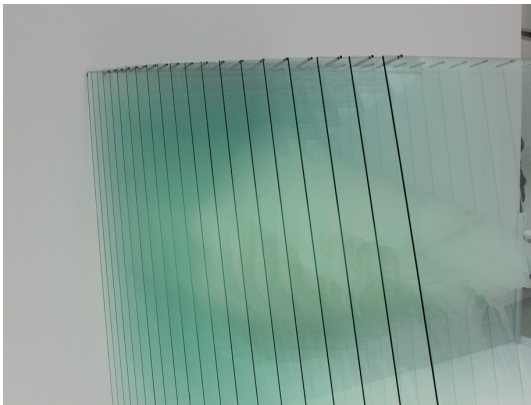
